

Auditing Report on the 2025 accounting of QGIS.ORG

As elected auditors, we audited the financial accountings and the financial report of QGIS.ORG edited by the treasurer Andreas Neumann for the year ended December 31, 2025.

The expenses and incomes were checked based on the bank statements. Each expense and income could be recognized as justified by appropriate receipts / invoices. The financial report is in accordance with the expense and income sheets.

The starting point of our audit is the budget proposal 2025 approved by AGM and published on <https://qgis.org>.

The total expenses of €447,903.04 were around €58,000.00 lower compared to the budgeted total expenses of €505,850. This was mainly because work for the Refactoring of the Attribute table has been postponed and the final costs for the Contributor meeting in Norrköping were significantly less than budgeted.

The total income of €455,627.94 was around €17,000 lower compared to the budgeted total income of €473,000. The income from Sustaining members was lower, whereas more donations than expected have been received.

We like to thank Andreas Neumann for yet another year of hard work.
We recommend that these financial statements for 2025 be approved.
